A New Model for Data Translation and Data Integration Processes

In concert with the advent of its .NET®-enabled EnSite Safari Suite® Version 4, EnSite today announced the commencement of its integration project for Microsoft® BizTalk® server. Over the next several months, a special team of EnSite associates will be establishing the company's new model for data translation and integration utilizing the industry-leading technology of Microsoft® BizTalk® server.

BizTalk® server is Microsoft's business solution for system integration and process automation. First released in 2000, it is now used by over 7,000 businesses to help manage systems and processes across the enterprise.

EnSite is now developing its plan for integrating Microsoft® BizTalk® server into its deployment model for EnSite Safari Suite®. Upon completion of this project, data in and out of EnSite Safari Suite® will be handled as configuration of the *system* rather than an enhancement to the *product*. Safari will communicate with Microsoft® BizTalk® server, which can coordinate the manipulation and transformation of data for integration with third party systems such as Utility EDI, Risk, Credit, and others.

The integration of Microsoft® BizTalk® server will establish another landmark event in EnSite's new era of energy management. Coupled with the release of its .NET®-enabled EnSite Safari Suite® Version 4, this new model for data translation and system integration will allow EnSite and its clients unprecedented operations and data management efficiency, helping streamline and standardize configuration of data-intensive processes involving EnSite Safari Suite® and third party systems.
